All volunteers receive training for their respective assignments.

Additional Volunteer Programs

Corporation for National and Community Service AmeriCorps VISTA program

NESF is the host agency for this program in Essex County, NJ and is thereby responsible for placing volunteers internally and externally with the goal of assisting in fund development, capacity building, and organizational development.

Community Work Experience Program

In partnership with the Essex County Department of Economic Development, Training & Employment, our agency participates in training individuals transitioning from welfare to work. Participants placed at our agency age taught relevant employable skills that will enable them to find employment and become self-sufficient.

Mature Workers Program

NESF is a host site for the Urban League of Essex County Mature Worker Program. Adults 55 years and older are assigned to our facility and are taught skills to assist in the transition from retirement to re-entry into the workforce. Participants have worked at our agency as case managers, case aides and administrative assistants.

NESF is committed to providing quality services to individuals and families who need assistance with emergency food, clothing, shelter, utilities, rent, and other basic necessities during times of crisis. 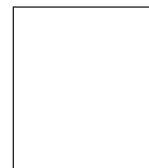

Emergency Services

Everyday, NESF's Emergency Services Unit responds to various situations, such as alleviating the needs of a displaced family seeking immediate shelter or the woman seeking safety from a domestic violent situation. NESF operates a 24-Hour Hotline for those in an emergency situation.

The Emergency Services Unit often serves as a family's initial contact with NESF. Many clients then continue to obtain additional agency services as NESF lends them a "helping hand". Emergency services include, rental/mortgage assistance to prevent eviction & homelessness, utilities assistance, domestic violence referrals, food bags and clothing, emergency shelter, and more. **Shelter Plus Care**

Corporation for Supportive Housing Program helps provide long-term housing subsidies and supportive services to individuals on their way to self-sufficiency.

Homeless Services

Drop-In Center

We operate a "Drop-In" Center that provides light meals, showers, and laundry facilities for the homeless of Essex County.

Food & Clothing Pantry

Through in-kind donations from the community and the New Jersey Community Food Bank, we generously distribute food bags, clothing, personal hygienic products, toiletries, household items, and furniture to any client in need.

Health & Senior Services

The Health & Senior Services provides quality health care to underinsured and uninsured patients in need with a particular emphasis on older adults. NESF partners with Newark Community Health Centers, Inc. (NCHC) to provide primary care services including medical care. NCHC accepts various medical insurances and offers an affordable sliding fee scale for those without insurance.

Free Eye Screenings

In collaboration with the NJ Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired and New Eyes for the Needy, NESF offers free eye screenings.

Additional Health & Senior Services

- Referrals for substance abuse and mental health screenings
- Nutrition and physical wellness
- Rental, mortgage, or utilities assistance and intensive case management for those living with HIV/AIDS

Self-Sufficiency Services

This unit provides intensive and holistic case management with compassion and professionalism. Core services include: intensive case management, long-term planning through Individual Service Plans (ISP's), employment assistance, Adkins life skills training for job readiness, health care and mental health counseling, housing assistance, and more.

Reintegration Program

The Reintegration Program assists men and women transitioning back into society from incarceration by

providing them with intensive case management, individual and group counseling, moral support and encouragement, mentoring, and linkages to additional support services.

Supportive Assistance to Individuals & Families (SAIF)

SAIF was developed to create a safety net for those families and individuals who exhausted their five-year time limit on welfare and do not meet the criteria for an exemption to the time limit. NESF's SAIF program couples intensive case management with a continuation of the service available to WFNJ recipients.

Family & Youth Development

This department is designed to strengthen and unify families by partnering with parents, caregivers, children, and communities through compassionate and meaningful family empowerment programs.

NESF Family Success Center

The center is a one-stop resource for referrals, information, and supportive services designed to assist families in accessing the help they need. Through this program we can extend the breadth of services to provide long-term solutions to strengthen families in need.

After School Programs

This program is for homeless youth and children in crisis. NESF creates a safe and nurturing environment in order to help the youth grow intellectually, socially, and emotionally. Children receive healthy meals, homework assistance, and tutoring services.
